A valid MMSCL card is required to participate in the reading club. The adult reading club is intended for patrons age 18 and older. ■

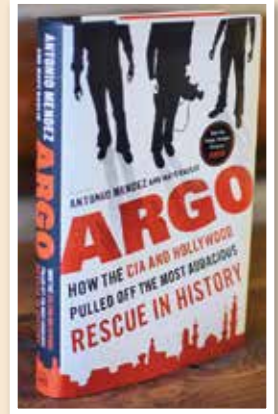
