Saturday, September 10, 9:00 a.m.

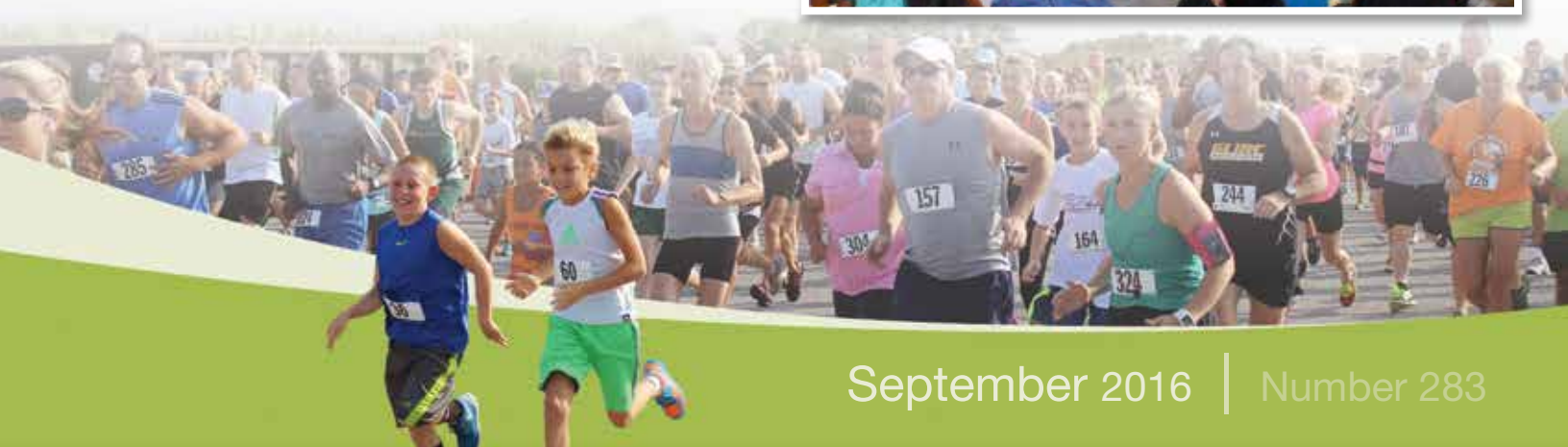

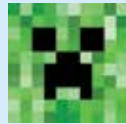

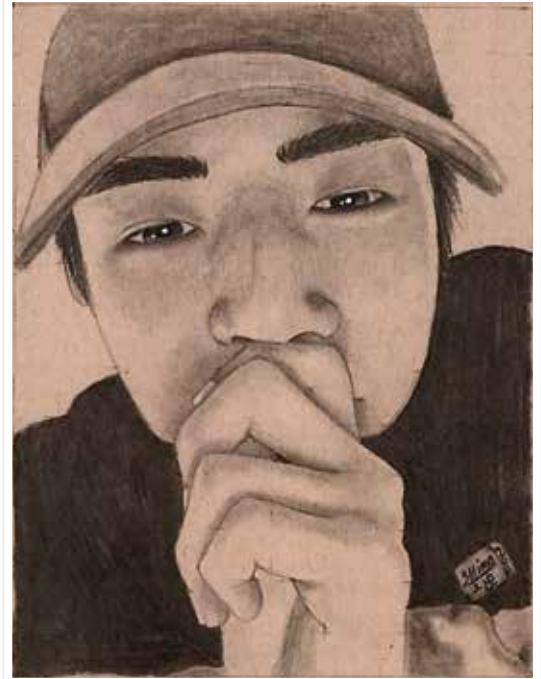
