CRAFTS

Yarn-Weave Supplies "Basket"

Materials

- Yarn (multiple colors)
- Popsicle sticks (20 or so)
- Paper Cup
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions

- 1) Cut the paper cup in half, keeping the bottom part and throwing away the rest.
- 2) Glue the Popsicle sticks around the sides of the cup bottom, leaving a little space between each stick. This should create a sort of fence around the cup. Let the glue dry.
- 3) Tie one end of yarn to a Popsicle stick, then weave the yarn through the sticks, behind one stick, then above the next, spiraling upwards.
- 4) If you want to switch over to another color of yarn, tie the free end of one to the next with a tight knot, then continue weaving.
- 5) Once you've finished, cut the free end of yarn short and glue it to the inside of the nearest Popsicle stick.
- 6) Let the glue dry, and then fill your little basket with pencils, pens, or any other school supplies you might need.
