BEHAVIOR IN THE LIBRARY & on LIBRARY PROPERTY

Abusive and/or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated in the Community Library since a major function of the Library is to provide a place for reading, research and quiet study.

The professional staff and security guards are authorized to suspend people from the Library for up to fifteen (15) days for failure to abide by Library rules.

The Director is authorized to permanently suspend individuals from entering onto Library property.

The Director is authorized to create and post rules regarding acceptable behavior in the Library and on Library property.

During times of a public health emergency and/or infectious disease outbreak when patrons are required to wear a mask in public places, library patrons or visitors failing to and/or refusing to wear a mask will be required to immediately leave the building.

The Library will abide by social distancing and group gathering dictates that the town, county or state enact, and will require groups to leave the premises if they are in violation of such orders.

Loitering or remaining or congregating on Library property for a reason not related to usage of the Library facility will be deemed to be a trespass and will subject any violator to criminal charges as well as to discipline up to and including a permanent suspension from entering onto Library property.
